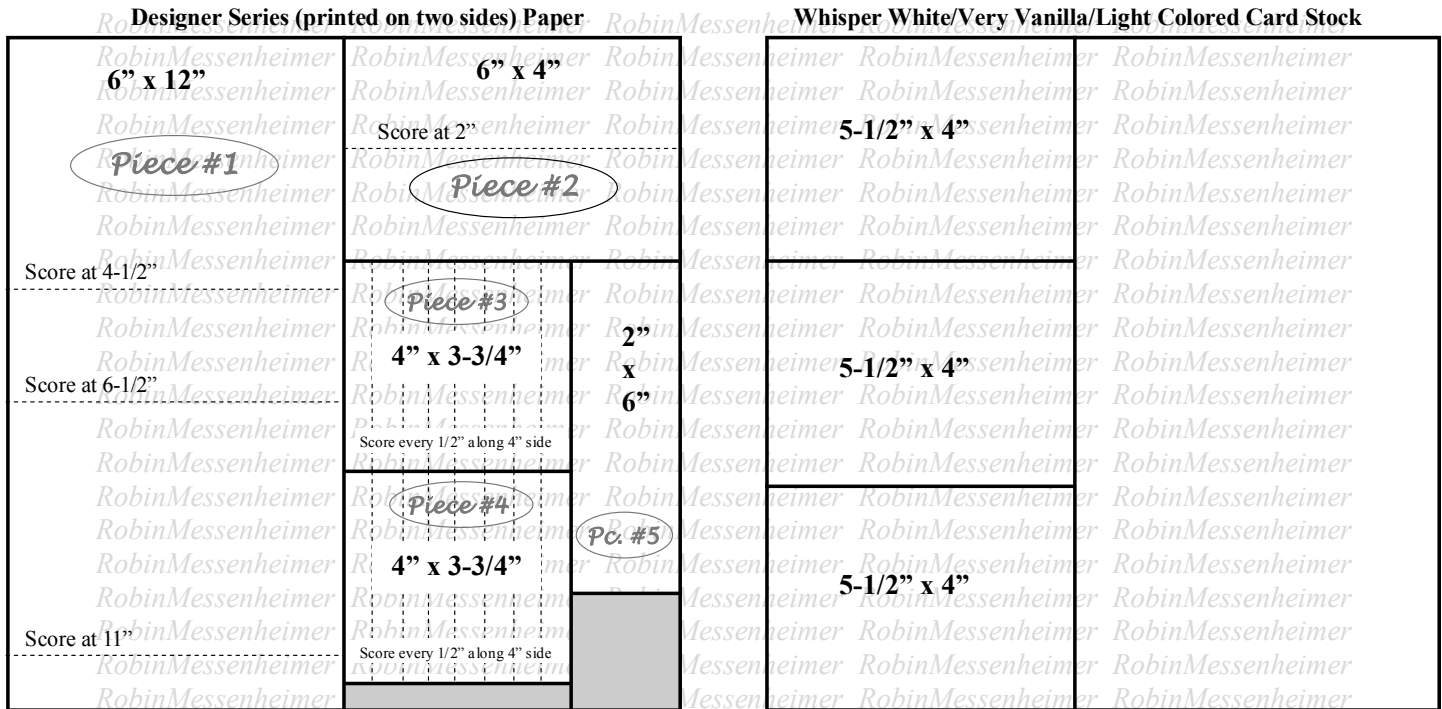


Box for Greeting Cards

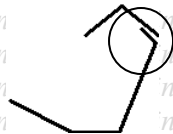

- Supplies:**
- One 12" square piece of Stampin' Up! Designer Series Paper (printed on both sides)
 - One 12" square piece of Whisper White, Very Vanilla, or other light colored coordinating Card Stock
 - Magnets or Velcro material for closure.
 - 30" piece of Stampin' Up! Ribbon to coordinate with Designer Series Paper
 - Sticky Strip Tape for all adhesive work for this project
 - Optional: Border Punch, Punch for Divider Labels

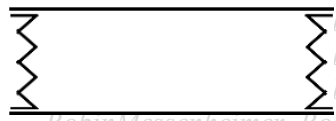
Instructions: Cut and score papers/card stock as shown below.



1. Fold and crease on all score lines of Piece #1.
2. Fold and crease on score line of Piece #2. Optional: Punch a fancy border on one 6" edge, the bottom of the front flap.
3. Position Piece #1 so that the 1" folded end is facing you. Adhere the non-punched 6" edge of Piece #2 to the outside of the 1" folded end of Piece #1.
4. Accordion fold along all score lines of Pieces #3 and #4.
5. Adhere one 1/2" end of Pieces #3 and #4 to one 4-1/2" side of Piece #1. Then adhere the other 1/2" end of Pieces #3 and #4 to the other 4-1/2" side. Looking down into the "box," this is how the pieces meet.



6. Tie the Ribbon around the top of the box, making a bow on the outside. Position the ribbon where you want it to stay and secure the ribbon to the inside of the top of the box with a piece of "scotch" tape.
7. Position Piece #5 of the Designer Series Paper to cover the ribbon and the seam you made in step 3, above, and adhere with sticky strip tape.
8. Apply magnet or Velcro closures to the inside of the front



9. Circle Punch. The magnetic pieces sold by Stampin' Up! are too thick for punching.
9. Position the pieces of Card Stock in the folds of the accordion pleated sides of the box.
10. If you wish, use a punch of your choice to make labels to affix to the top of the divider cards.
