





Bow Topper for Ball Ornaments

1. Form the first loop as you would for a "cause" ribbon. Hold down the tail to the left, form a curve, twisting the ribbon so the same side of the ribbon is "up" as the tail. Cross the tail with the ribbon. 
2. Repeat this same kind of curve with the ribbon, bringing it around to the middle with the ribbon roughly parallel to the original tail. 
3. Form a 3rd loop in the same way as the first two, with this 3rd loop falling in between the first two. 
4. Form a fourth loop, falling between the first two on the opposite side of the first. 



You can continue with this process, making the loops smaller in the second and succeeding rows. When you are finished, hold the ribbon together with a pin and sew together. If you are using as a topper for a Styrofoam ornament, simply stick the pin into the Styrofoam. If you make the very last loop a small circle, the pin will not show very much at all. If you have made many layers, use a 1-1/4" or longer straight pin to attach.

Another option is to finish one row with one color then add other colors in the second and succeeding rows.
