This project focuses on the Lattice Fold at the left side of this card front. Measurements and supplies for the entire card are provided. PLEASE NOTE: The Lattice Fold is going to look good even if your measurements are not perfect.

Have fun playing around with different measurements and cuts!

Supply List:

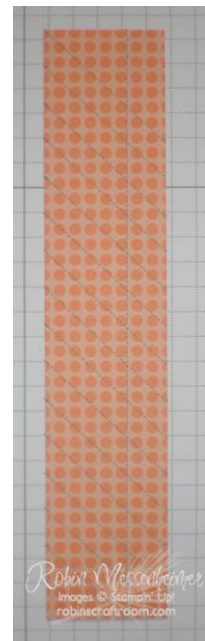
- **Stamp Sets:** *Touch of Kindness*
- **Inks:** *Wild Wasabi, Baja Breeze, Peach Parfait, So Saffron*
- **Cardstock:** *So Saffron, Wild Wasabi, Baja Breeze*
- **Accessories:** *Just Add Cake DSP, Whisper White Brads (from the Neutrals set), So Saffron 3/8" Taffeta Ribbon (18") (This is new in the 2011-2012 Catalog, but not available when this project was made; the ribbon on the sample is Daffodil Delight)*
- **Tools Needed:** *Mat Pack, Paper Piercer, 1-1/4" and 1-3/8" Circle Punches; Ruler; Mini Glue Dots*

Measurements for Lattice Fold Piece:

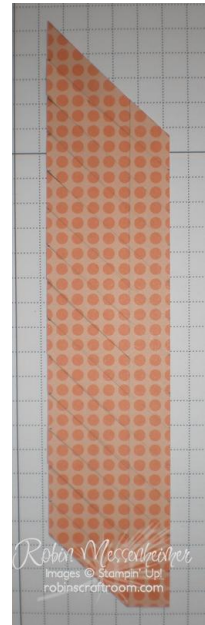
One piece of DSP 1-1/4" wide x 6" high

Detailed Instructions:

1. Measure and make a mark every 3/8" along both long sides of the DSP.
2. Laying the DSP so that the short ends are top and bottom, draw a light pencil line from the top mark on the left (long) side to the 3rd mark down on the right (long) side. Continue until you reach the 2nd to the last mark on the left side. Draw a light pencil line parallel to and 3/8" in from the right side. (I've drawn over the picture on the left to show the lines better.)



- Beginning at the top left, cut along all diagonal lines from the left edge to the vertical pencil line. The bottom line will cut through to the bottom edge of the paper. Trim the topmost cut through to the right edge. Gently erase the pencil lines.



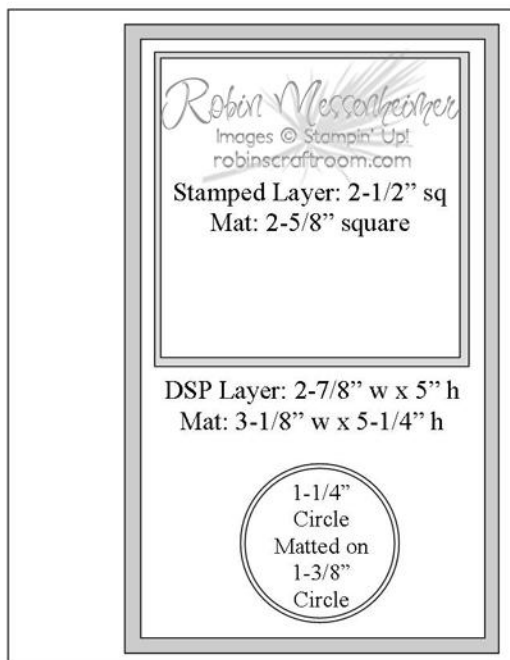
- Beginning with the topmost strip, fold the left edge down to meet the left edge of the third strip down. The fold will start at the right at the vertical pencil line and should be parallel to the top. Repeat with alternate strips (3, 5, 7, 9, etc.)
- The Lattice Fold part of this project is complete!



Instructions for making the sample card shown.

Using Mat Pack and Paper Piercer, punch hole in the center of each place where the folded strip overlaps an unfolded strip. Insert Whisper White Brad in each hole.

Basic Card: 4-1/4" wide x 5-1/2" high



Cut Card Stock and DSP as shown in sketch at left. Stamp, color and layer everything except the Lattice Fold and the Basic Card.

Tie 3/8" Taffeta Ribbon in a bow between the top and bottom stamped image layers.

Adhere the right edge of the Lattice Fold element to the back left edge of the layered elements so that the 3/8" strip at the right of the Lattice Fold element is completely covered. Adhere to the card front using Mini Glue Dots behind the brads and adhesive of your choice for the layered element. Trim top and/or bottom of Lattice Fold element where it overlaps the card or card margins.

Cost: Supplies for this cost approximately \$1. I would use this as part of a 3-project class for which I normally charge \$20.
