

Treat Box for Square Candies *(such as Ghirardelli Chocolates)*

Materials Needed for Treat Holder Shown

Card Stock and Papers:

Melon Mambo—7-3/4" x 3"

Sunshine & Sprinkles Papers*

2 pieces 2-1/2" square (for outside)

1 piece 4" square (for inside)

Ink: Melon Mambo

Stamp Set: That's the Ticket*

Punch: Ticket Duo Builder Punch; Word Window Punch

Sizzix: Hearts a Flutter Framelit (small heart)*

Ribbon: Melon Mambo 3/8" Striped Organdy Ribbon*

Clip: Heart from Elements Cute Clips*

Adhesives: SNAIL, Sticky Strip

Other: Simply Scored

Instructions for Constructing Treat Holder

1. Score the Melon Mambo Card Stock at 3-1/2 and 4-1/4.
Fold, crease and set aside.



2. Score the 4" square piece of Paper at 1-5/8 and 2-3/8 on one side and at 1/2 and 3-1/2 on the other.



3. With the side of the paper that you wish to show on the inside of the treat holder facing you, fold the sides with the 1/2" scores to the back (mountain fold).

Then fold and crease on the 1-5/8 and 2-3/8 scores toward you (valley folds).



4. Turn the paper over and adhere Sticky Strip along the 1/2" folds, making sure that the Sticky Strip is close to the fold lines.



5. Remove the Sticky Strip Cover and fold the paper inward, adhering the center section to the center section of the Melon Mambo Card Stock. Then, smoothing each edge as you go along, adhere the folded sides of the paper along the edge of the Card Stock.



6. Fold the Card Stock (with the paper adhered inside) bringing the short edges to meet at the top. Use the Word Window Punch to make a "handle" at the top of the treat holder.



7. Insert Ghirardelli Chocolate Squares as shown.

8. Decorate the outside of the treat holder as shown in the front page photo. I punched a heart in the center of the two small squares of the Sunshine and Sprinkles Paper using the small heart form the Framelits set.



9. Tie the "handles" together with ribbon.
