## **Punch Art Gingerbread Man Card**



This fun little guy is so simple to make and will make a great Christmas Card for a youngster—or someone who's young at heart!



## To make the GingerBread Man you'll need:

- 1" Circle Punch
- Small Tag Punch
- Word Window Punch
- Heart to Heart Punch
- White Signo Gel Pen
- Creamy Caramel Card Stock
- Scrap of Real Red Card Stock

Punch 1 Circle, 1 Small Tag, 1 of the smallest heart in the Heart to Heart Punch, and 4 Word Windows.

Decorate the punched pieces with the White Signo Gel Pen.

First apply the circle head to the top of the tab punch body, leaving some of the angled corners open. Attach the word window armsn and legs to the back of the tab body. I like to use two mini glue dots on each piece. If you use only one glue dot, the arms and legs will tend to swivel around.

Finally apply the little guy's heart with a mini glue dot.

## To make this card

Cut a scallop circle using the Sizzix Big Shot and the Scallop Die. I used a piece of Designer Series Paper from the set, Christmas Cocoa Specialty.

Stamp a Christmas or other holiday greeting on the scallop circle, using **VersaMark and White Stampin' Emboss Powder**. Heat emboss the greeting.

Tie a 16" piece of the Old Olive Ribbon from the "Mistletoe" Ribbon Originals set.

Adhere the scallop circle to a contrasting piece of Designer Series Paper cut 4-3/4" square. I used an old olive colored piece from the set, Merry Moments. Then adhere this group to a 5" square of Real Red Card Stock, and this final group to a 5-1/4" square card made from a 5-1/4" x 10-1/2" piece of Creamy Caramel card stock.

Finally, attach the Gingerbread Man to the card, using **Stampin' Dimensionals.**
