## Card Stock and Papers

2 Main Color CS	2" x	5"
3 Coordinating Print	8" x	3-1/2"
4 Coordinating	1-1/2" x	6"

5 Coordinating	1-1/2" x	6"

## Stampin Up Stamp Sets

Alphabet set, not too large  
—Typeset; lower case of  
Defining Alphabet would work

Stampin Around wheel or  
background stamp and  
other small decorative  
stamps as you wish

## Stamp Pads to Match/Coordinate

Ribbon to Match/Coordinate 8"

## Equipment

1" square punch; 1-1/8" square punch  
Glue stick or SNAIL; Sticky Strip



8 x 5" pad of white lined paper. I used a pad with 50 sheets; adjust size of paper #1 for a larger pad

Colors for the sample are So Saffron, Certainly Celery, Old Olive, Pretty in Pink and Tea Party DSP

- Score paper #1 twice, 5" in from each short edge. Fold in towards score and crease with bone folder.
- Score paper #2 twice, 3/4" and 1" from a long edge. Fold in towards score and crease with bone folder.
- Decorate front of booklet made by paper #1.
  - Sample was stamped with a Stampin Around wheel called "Fast Flowers." Use any wheel or background stamp to coordinate with the DSP.
  - Attach paper #3 at or near right edge of cover. Trim top and/or bottom if needed.
  - Attach 8" piece of ribbon to center of paper #3. Trim if needed.
  - Cut 5 or 6 squares from paper #4 with 1-1/8" square punch..
  - Stamp the letters for your name or other word or decoration on paper #5.
  - Cut letters out with 1" square punch.
  - Attach the stamped squares to the 1-1/8" squares, and then attach those over the ribbon onto paper #3.
- Using sticky strip, attach paper #2 to top of pad of paper, making sure that the longer side covers the top of the pad. Before attaching, trim the 1" side so it just covers the liner at the top of the pad or the paper in the pad will not tear well.
- Using sticky strip, attach pad to inside back of booklet formed by paper #1.
- Using decorative stamps, stamp on a lower corner of each page in the pad of paper (optional).
- Use marker to dye edge of pad (optional).
