Card Measurements are:

Very Vanilla, 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" folded to be a 5-1/2" wide by 4-1/4" tall card. 2-3/4" x 1" (for stamped greeting)

Real Red Card Stock: 5-3/8" x 4-1/8" 2-7/8" x 1-1/8"

Designer Series Paper (I used Merry Moments) 5-1/4" x 4"



Stamp Set: Four the Holidays



To make one poinsettia you'll need:

- 5-Petal Flower Punch (109041)
- Scrap of Real Red Card Stock large enough to punch two 5-Petal Flowers
- Bone Folder (102300)
- Paper Piercing Tool (116631)
- Paper piercing pad from Mat Pack (105826)
- Gold Brads (104337)



Score each flower at the base of each of the 5 Petals, using the bone folder. The dashed lines show where scores should be placed. Fold each petal up just a bit on each score line.



Roll each of the petals on both flowers over the paper piercing tool to give the petals some curl.



Once both flowers are scored, folded and curled, adhere one on top of the other, with the petals alternating.



Using the paper piercer and mat, make 6 holes in the center of the flower—1 in the very center and 5 surrounding it evenly.







To affix the poinsettias to the card, apply one Stampin' Dimensional to the back of each petal of the bottom layer of the flower.
